



## 2015-2016 Campaign Finances Pennsylvania Congressional Delegation

1Q 2016

The campaign committee of **Sen. Pat Toomey**, R, of Zionsville, raised \$20,086,730 and spent more than \$11,100,000 through March 31, 2016, and ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$9,140,557.

His Democratic opponent, **Katie McGinty**, of Philadelphia, had campaign receipts of \$3,812,650 and disbursements of more than \$2,800,000 through March 31, and ended the quarter with \$953,644 cash on hand.



**Rep. Robert Brady**, D-1, of Philadelphia, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$549,473 and had revenue of \$439,460 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$988,933 as of March 31, 2016. After spending \$501,459, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$487,474.

**Deborah Williams**, his Republican opponent in the Nov. 8 election, had reported no campaign-finance activity to the Federal Election Commission by March 31.



The 2nd Congressional District has an open seat in the Nov. 8 election.

The campaign fund of Democrat **Dwight Evans** raised \$877,068 through March 31, 2016, and after spending \$553,122, ended the quarter with \$323,946 cash on hand.

Republican **James Jones** had reported no campaign-finance activity to the Federal Election Commission by March 31.



**Rep. Ryan Costello**, R-6, of West Chester, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$122,160 and had revenue of \$1,606,029 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$1,728,189 as of March 31, 2016. After spending more than \$510,000, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$1,218,098.

**Mike Parrish**, Costello's Democratic opponent in the Nov. 8 election, raised \$143,806 through March 31 and ended the quarter with a campaign balance of \$15,911.



**Rep. Patrick Meehan**, R-7, of Drexel Hill, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$1,671,202 and had revenue of 1,677,573 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$3,348,775 as of March 31, 2016. After spending more than \$822,700, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$2,526,005.

**Mary Ellen Balchunis**, Meehan's Democratic opponent on Nov. 8, raised \$62,676 through March 31 and ended the quarter with \$17,337 cash on hand.





The 8th Congressional District has an open seat in the Nov. 8 election.

Democrat **Steve Santarsiero** raised \$1,128,053 through March 31, 2016, and ended 1Q 2016 with a campaign balance of \$301,607.

Republican **Brian Fitzpatrick** raised \$452,203 through March 31 and his campaign fund ended the quarter with \$413,377 cash on hand.



**Rep. Brendan Boyle**, D-13, of Philadelphia, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$415,223 and had revenue of \$701,543 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$1,116,766 as of March 31, 2016. After disbursements, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$496,808.

Boyle is unopposed in the Nov. 8 election.



**Rep. Charlie Dent**, R-15, of Allentown, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$937,816 and had revenue of \$927,667 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$1,865,483 as of March 31, 2016. After spending \$644,858, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$1,220,625.

His opponent on Nov. 8, Democrat **Rick Daugherty**, had raised \$300 by March 31 and ended the quarter with \$222 cash on hand.



The 16th Congressional District has an open seat in the Nov. 8 election.

Republican **Lloyd Smucker** raised \$549,173 and spent \$443,924 through March 31, 2016, and ended 1Q 2016 with a campaign balance of \$105,249.

Democrat **Christina Hartman** raised \$233,725 and spent \$106,736 through March 31, and her campaign fund ended the quarter with \$126,989 cash on hand.

Independent **Edward Haggerty** had reported no campaign-finance activity to the Federal Election Commission as of March 31.



**Rep. Matt Cartwright**, D-17, of Moosic, began 2015 with a campaign fund of \$453,074 and had revenue of \$616,013 over the next 15 months, for total receipts of \$1,069,087 as of March 31, 2016. After spending \$334,661, his campaign ended 1Q 2016 with a political war chest of \$734,426.

His Republican opponent on Nov. 8, **Matt Connolly**, raised \$9,515 through March 31 and ended the quarter with \$4,484 cash on hand.
